How the Federal Funding Package Can Impact the Hemp Industry

The pending federal budget and government funding package includes a significant revision to the federal definition of “hemp” under the 2018 Farm Bill — a change that would narrow what qualifies as hemp and dramatically reshape the national hemp industry.

- **THC limit:** A limit of 0.4mg of THC per package, including THCA, D8, and other intoxicating isomers.
- **Ban on synthetic cannabinoids:** Prohibits “any cannabinoid synthesized or manufactured outside the plant.”
- **Effective date:** Takes effect one year after enactment
- **Next step:** The measure must still pass the U.S. House of Representatives – which can happen as soon as TODAY, Wednesday, November 12.
